Exchange students are expected to successfully enroll in a full course of study each semester of their exchange program, as defined by the host university/institute. Failure to do so could result in falling out of good standing with Middlebury College/MIIS and the U.S. Government. At Middlebury, the normal course load is three credit-bearing courses per fall and spring terms and one credit-bearing course during the winter. At MIIS, a full course of study is 12-16 credits per semester.

You will be assigned an academic advisor prior to your arrival at Middlebury whom you will meet with when you arrive to campus.
